

Scholarships and Fellowships in Japan (Eligible for Tanzanians)

1. Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship

- **Covers:** Undergraduate, Master's, PhD, College of Technology, Specialized Training, and Teacher Training Programs.
- **Benefits:** Full tuition, monthly stipend, and airfare.
- **Deadline:** Usually May–June (varies by Embassy).
- Link: MEXT Scholarship

2. JICA Knowledge Co-Creation Programs (KCCP)

- **Covers:** Short- and long-term training in areas such as infrastructure, statistics, agriculture, public policy, and industrial development.
- Eligibility: Government and institutional officers.
- Mode: Through nomination by Tanzanian authorities (Ministry of Foreign Affairs or PO-PSMGG).

3. OIST Research Internship Program (Okinawa Institute of Science and Technology)

- **Covers:** 2–6 months internship in advanced science and technology fields (Physics, AI, Biology, Chemistry, etc.).
- Deadline: Usually AprilLink: OIST Internship

4. JSPS Fellowships (Japan Society for the Promotion of Science)

- Types:
 - Postdoctoral Fellowship (Standard / Short-term / Long-term)
 - o Invitational Fellowship for Research in Japan
- Fields: All research areas in natural and social sciences.
- Deadlines:

Short-term: AprilLong-term: August

5. ICYS Research Fellowships at NIMS (National Institute for Materials Science)

- Covers: Postdoctoral research in materials science, nanotechnology, energy, and related fields.
- Cycles:

Spring: Deadline – March

Autumn: Deadline – September

6. Permanent Researcher and Postdoctoral Positions at NIMS

Deadline: June

Focus: Advanced materials and energy research.

7. Postdoctoral Fellowships at JAEA (Japan Atomic Energy Agency)

Deadline: May

• Field: Nuclear science, radiation safety, energy systems, and related areas.

8. Abe Initiative (African Business Education Initiative for Youth)

• Covers: Master's degree + internship in Japanese companies.

• Focus: Human resource and business linkage between Africa and Japan.

• Managed by: JICA and MOFA Japan.

• **Deadline:** Usually December–February.

9. Matsumae International Foundation (MIF) Research Fellowship

• Covers: 3–6 month research stay in Japan for PhD holders.

• **Deadline:** Around June each year.

• Fields: Natural sciences, engineering, medicine.

10. The Visiting Researcher Program – Bishop Williams Memorial Fund

Deadline: October 11 annually.

Focus: Humanities, theology, and cultural research.

12. SDGs Global Leader Program (Japan)

• **Covers:** Master's-level programs focused on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), leadership, and policy innovation.

• Eligibility: International students and mid-career professionals.

• Benefits: Tuition, living allowance, and airfare.

• **Deadline:** varies with Program from April - September

11. Human Resources Development in the Mining Sector – KIZUNA Program (Japan)

- **Covers:** Training for professionals in the mining sector, including policy, safety, and management.
- **Eligibility:** Government officers, researchers, and professionals from resource-rich countries.
- Mode: Short-term training in Japan; usually funded by Japanese Government or associated ministries.

12. SDGs Global Leader Program (Japan)

- **Covers:** Master's-level programs focused on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), leadership, and policy innovation.
- **Eligibility:** International students and mid-career professionals.
- Benefits: Tuition, living allowance, and airfare.

18. Honjo International Scholarship Foundation Scholarships (Japan)

- Covers: Undergraduate and graduate-level scholarships for international students.
- **Fields:** Various, depending on program.
- **Eligibility**: Non-Japanese students demonstrating academic excellence and leadership potential.
- **Benefits:** Tuition, stipend, and partial living support.

13. Sustainable Urban Planning and Urban Transportation Development (Japan)

- **Covers:** Short- and medium-term programs focusing on urban planning, transport policy, and sustainable city development.
- Eligibility: Government officers, urban planners, and researchers.
- **Mode:** Sponsored by JICA / Japanese universities; classroom and field-based training.

14. Water Engineering and Utility Management for Future Leaders (Japan)

- **Covers:** Training for engineers and policy officers in water resource management, utility operations, and sustainable water infrastructure.
- Eligibility: Mid-career professionals and researchers from developing countries.
- Mode: Sponsored training in Japan.

15. Human Resources Development for Governmental Officers and Researchers in Minerals Resources Rich Countries (Japan)

- Covers: Technical and policy-oriented training on mining, resource management, and mineral economics.
- Eligibility: Government officials and researchers from resource-rich countries.
- Mode: Short-term training programs in Japan.

16. Agriculture Studies Networks for Food Security (Japan)

- **Covers:** Programs and research focused on agriculture, food security, and sustainable agricultural technologies.
- **Eligibility:** Researchers, government officers, and students from developing countries.
- Mode: Short- and medium-term training, sometimes combined with Master's programs.

17. Capacity Development for Officials of the Ministry of Finance and Planning through Master's Degree Programs (Japan)

- **Covers:** Fully-funded Master's programs for Tanzanian finance officials and related staff, focusing on public finance, policy, and planning.
- **Eligibility:** Government officers nominated by Tanzanian Ministry of Finance and Planning.
- Benefits: Tuition, living stipend, and airfare.
